Jacques Offenbach was born at Offenbach on Main on 21 June 1819 and entered the Paris Conservatoire as a cellist in 1833. He composed about 90 operettas for the Parisian stage and towards the end of his life determined to write an opera on a larger scale. He wrote a libretto founded on 'Hoffmann's Erzählungen' but unfortunately died a few months before its production at the Opéra Comique on February 10, 1881.
